FEEDING GUIDE

Daily feeding rate varies from animal to animal. Typically commence feeding your animals between 1 - 1.5% by body weight per day. Introduce the feed to your livestock at a 1-2 kg per day and supervise. After 3 days gradually

introduce more feed as the rumen adapts. Keep a balance diet to ensure full productivity.

These feeding rates are suggestions only and all variables such as age, pasture quality, & etc. should be taken into account. Product is suitable and flows well through auto and self feeders or simply made available in open troughs.

It is recommendation that livestock always have access to adequate hay, pasture or silage whenever being fed high protein supplements. Ensure fresh clean water is available at all times.

NOTE

Nutritional analysis may vary due to seasonal factors and available resources. The above specifications are based on a typical analysis taken at the time of publishing.

It is recommended that the feed be used within 6 months from date of purchase.
